## MCCULLOCH COUNTY JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW AND SALE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The McCulloch County Junior Livestock Show and Sale Association is a group of people made up of parents and concerned citizens who are interested in sponsoring our county junior livestock show and sale and through this activity promoting youth involvement in agriculture in McCulloch County through those who are involved in FFA and 4-H Club work. Because we believe that our youth are our most valuable resource and our future, we wish to invest in their future by annually sponsoring 2 scholarships in the amount of **\$1000.00 each (\$500 per semester).** These scholarships will be based on involvement in the McCulloch County Livestock Show and Sale, FFA and/or 4-H activities, scholarship, leadership, community service, other activities, and awards and honors.

## GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS

- 1. To be given to 2 qualified McCulloch County graduating senior students yearly and more when possible.
- 2. Applicant must be a senior attending a McCulloch County high school or be home schooled in a McCulloch County school district.
- 3. Applicant must have a high school diploma or a home school equivalent.
- 4. Applicant must have been accepted to a college or trade school and have proof of acceptance.
- 5. Applicant must be actively involved and in good standing in a McCulloch County FFA or 4-H Club.
- 6. Applicant must have at least 2 years of participation in the McCulloch County Junior Livestock Show within the last 4 years.
- 7. Applications shall be submitted to the Extension Office on or before Thursday, April 21, 2023 <u>in a sealed envelope</u>.
- 8. Applicant must turn in a 1 to 2 page, typed or neatly handwritten essay explaining why they want this scholarship.
- 9. Applicants must submit a copy of their high school transcript.
- 10. The association and its scholarship committee reserve the right to hold interviews with all finalists.
- 11. The association will pay scholarships awarded directly to the recipients in August and January upon proof of enrollment in a university, vocational or technical school, or some other higher education institution. The recipient: shall be responsible for contacting the treasurer of the association for payment.
- 12. If applicant has not lived in a McCulloch County School District for the past 2 years then he or she should explain why in an extra and brief paragraph and should use previous involvement from previous home.
